Article VI, Section 9, M: Bylaw proposal

2024 Financial Spotlight



- We will meet our budget this year
- Moving reserve funds to high yield accounts
- Clarified financial policies (e.g. Secular Fund use, financial review/audit)



- Without unexpected bequests this year, "giving from the living" is down ~15%
- We need to set aside funds annually in capital reserves
 \$200k+ roof resurfacing
 - \$150k+ HVAC upgrade/replace



Annual Membership Meeting

Solar Renewable Energy Exploration Phase

Why consider this:

- 1. Solid financial value: 9% 10% ROI; savings of ~\$20k / year
- 2. Aligns with Unity values of responsible stewardship of nature.
- 3. Bragging rights (PR) We're walking the talk here.

Steps along the pathway

- Resurface roof
- Funding: grants & capital fundraising
- Help with grant research & application
