Financial Update: 2021 Ended Well

Pandemic restrictions impacted income all year. PPP loan helped keep operating loss to \$54,000, below projection. Cash loss was smaller but still required tapping reserves.

Despite the challenges several noteworthy financial advances:

- Investment in facility/grounds for church reopening and school conversion.
- Above average paydown of property mortgage.
- Mildred Park Endowment investment gains

Financials: High Hopes for 2022

Our financial expectations hinge on recovery of love offerings to 2020 levels.

- Even with that recovery we project an operating loss higher than 2021 (no PPP loan) – close to \$80,000, about 10%.
- Cash use less but will further deplete rather than add to reserves.

If love offerings stay at 2021 levels, we'll feel more financial stress

Critical importance of re-engaging the full congregation and reaching out to the community. We've done it before!!
